## Mahatma Gandhi



Mohandas 'Mahatma' Gandhi <sup>1</sup> was (be) born on October 2<sup>nd</sup> 1869, in Porbandar, India. He <sup>2</sup> (study) law at University College, London and then <sup>3</sup> (work) as a lawyer in South Africa for 21 years. Gandhi <sup>4</sup> (leave) South Africa in 1915 and <sup>5</sup> (return) to India. He <sup>6</sup> (become) the leader of the fight for Indian independence from the British. Gandhi spent\* seven years in prison and India <sup>7</sup> (become) independent in 1947. Mahatma Gandhi <sup>8</sup> (die) in 1948.

## Emmeline Pankhurst



Emmeline Goulden <sup>9</sup> (be) born in Manchester, England, in 1858. She <sup>10</sup> (marry) Richard Pankhurst, a lawyer, and they <sup>11</sup> (have) five children. In 1889 Emmeline <sup>12</sup> (start) The Women's Party to fight for the vote\* for women. They <sup>13</sup> (have) a lot of problems with the police and in 1912 Emmeline <sup>14</sup> (go) to prison twelve times. They finally <sup>15</sup> (win) the vote for all women in 1928. Emmeline <sup>16</sup> (die) in the same year.

The life story of Nelson Mandela. - Write the biography in the Past simple tense.

Nelson Mandela is born in Natal in 1918. His father is the chief of the Tembu tribe. He starts school when he is nine years old. Then he goes to university. He finishes university in 1942 and he goes to Johannesburg. There he works as a lawyer and he defends black people. In 1944 he is the leader of the ANC (African National Congress). He campaigns for the abolition of apartheid for eighteen years. He is arrested in 1963. He is in prison during 27 years. He is freed in 1990. In 1993 Mandela wins the Nobel Peace Prize and in 1994 he is elected president of the new democracy in South Africa.
